

Craft with Spirit Throw Pillow



You will need:
1 Altar Cloth
1 Pillow form
Cloth for pillow back
Neddles, thread
Scissors, chalk
Measuring tape
Sewing machine



Pick a pillow form that is larger than the design of the grid pattern on the altar cloth.

Cut a piece of backing material 1" bigger than the pillow form. For this Seed of Life Altar cloth I used a 16" pillow form and cut the material 17" square.

To center your grid pattern on your pillow use a pin to mark the center as shown. Find the exact center of the material by folding it in fourths. Mark the center with a pencil or chalk on the wrong side of the fabric.

Put the altar cloth and backing material together right sides facing. Center the pencil mark on the material over the head of the pen by feeling through the material for the pen head. Pin the two materials together.

Cut the altar cloth to match the pillow backing in size.

Sew 1/2" from the edge around all four sides leaving a gap on one side large enough to squish the pillow form through.

Turn the pillow cover right side out. Stuff the pillow form inside the cover. Sew up the gap by hand.
